Ultimate Life Christian Academy Explanation of Fees & Payment Options

All fees must be paid by the first day of school and are non-refundable.

Registration Fee includes the covering of initial expenses, diagnostic and achievement testing, student insurance (required), offset costs of some field trips, and other activity expenses. Due to limited space, **this fee must be paid to reserve a pending placement for your child(ren).**

Curriculum (PACE) Fee covers the use of consumable educational materials as well as curriculum. The Academy only orders PACEs when this fee is **prepaid**. **This fee is due on July 1, 2013, or on the day of registration if it is after July 1.** The last day to pay this PACE fee to ensure materials are ready the first day of school is August 21, 2013. At any time during the academic year, should your student leave the academy, the PACE fee cannot be reimbursed. The PACEs the student is currently working in, that are not finished, may be retained by the student. NOTE: Should your student(s) lose or have to repeat a PACE, there is a charge of \$7.00 per PACE per student.

Technology Fee – for High School students only. This fee covers the cost of the technology course to train the students in Microsoft Office, Windows and Internet experience.

A **Tuition** payment plan may be discussed with the financial officer (by appointment) and arranged on an individual basis.

All payments must be made in the administration office. **Please do not pay teachers or other staff except those designated to receive payments.** The office will retain duplicate receipt of your payment for record purposes. For any cash payment, be sure to retain receipt for proof of payment.

ULCA does not accept post-dated checks. Any check returned for insufficient funds or any reason will require an additional \$30 fee, payable in cash within three business days. If not, you will be required to remove your student(s) immediately, until the account is paid in full. Should you be unable to pay immediately, ULCA can only hold your child's place for fifteen days after removal. No transcripts, records, or communications can be forwarded until the student's account is paid in full. All payments, thereafter, will be accepted as cash, money order, or bank check.

Welcome to Ultimate Life Christian Academy (ULCA). Our academy is geared to assist students who desire to prepare for continuing education in college or technical school, or preparation for employment upon graduation from high school. Ultimate Life Christian Academy is committed to a disciplined, academic, creative environment.

Our basic philosophy is that Christian parents and guardians have the primary responsibility for training their children. We believe that parents have “contracted” with the academy to assist them in fulfilling their responsibility. It is our belief that the educational agreement is a team effort which includes the student, the parent, the teacher, portions of the community (especially the Christian community), the church, the academy and administrative staff.

In order for the academy to properly educate our students, the environment in the school must be physically, psychologically, and spiritually safe. This begins with respect for one another, which is a requirement for everyone involved with ULCA - the students, parents, teachers, and administrative staff. We expect students to be present physically and mentally. Some of ULCA's aims are:

- For students to grow in their relationship with God as they obtain daily instruction from His Word;
- For students to find fellowship (friendship) with one another;
- For students to be encouraged in their spiritual and educational pursuit;
- That teachers approach their students with wisdom, patience, and consideration, and are responsible and loyal to the administration;
- For the administration to promote conditions that provide its teachers freedom to work and minister in a responsible pursuit of truth and professional competence.

We believe a Christian education involves instruction and training that provide knowledge of the Scripture and Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord of our lives. Students and parents are expected to belong to a Bible-believing church where they attend regularly.

2. In one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (Deut. 6:4; Matt. 28:19; Mark 2:28)
3. In the virgin birth of Christ, His vicarious, atoning death, bodily resurrection, and ascension. (Is. 7:14; Rom. 8:34; Matt. 28:5-6)
4. In salvation through the Blood of Jesus Christ on the Cross. (Is. 53:4-8; Matt. 8:16-17)
5. In the baptism with the Holy Spirit with the initial evidence of speaking in other tongues. (Acts 10:44-46; 15:8-9)
6. In divine healing through the redemptive work of Christ on the Cross. (Is. 53:4-6; Matt. 8:16-17; James 5:13-14)
7. In the Five-Fold Ministry that is to equip believers for the work of the ministry so the Body of Christ can be properly edified. (Eph. 4:11-13)
8. In the sanctifying power of the Holy Spirit which enables a believer to live a holy life. (Heb. 12:14; I Peter 1:15-16)
9. In the second coming of Jesus Christ. (Luke 14:14; and Rev. 19:7-9, 11-13)

Ultimate Life Christian Academy Corporal Correction Release

Ultimate Life Christian Academy is honored that you have asked our staff to assist you in the training of your child for Christian leadership. Our total program is designed to develop the spiritual and academic qualities that characterize your child. We appreciate your confidence in our program. To carry out your wishes for total character development, we believe it is necessary to follow Scriptural admonition to correct a child when his/her behavior is in violation of proper or reasonable rules and procedures. These rules are clearly defined in the student guidelines. When warranted, corporal correction will be exercised under the following guidelines:

1. Your child will be removed for the correction so as not to embarrass or humiliate him/her.
2. The offense will be clearly discussed with your child.
3. A staff member will discuss spiritual applications with your child.
4. A reasonable number of strokes (1-3) will be administered by a staff member using a simple, flat paddle.
5. A staff witness (of the same gender as the child, when possible) will be present.
6. Your child will not be physically restrained. If he/she refuses to a paddling, you will be asked to come and discuss the matter, and paddle the child with the staff member present. If it is deemed in the best interest of the school, the child will be withdrawn from the academy.
7. After administering the strokes, the staff member will pray with your child, assuring him/her of their love. A written report will be filed, stating the date, the offense, the number of strokes, and the names of the correcting staff member and witness. A copy will be sent to you.
